GENERALLY, THE FISHERIES SHOULD BE SUBJECT TO
JOINT FEDERAL-PROVINCIAL MANAGEMENT WITH THE FEDERAL
GOVERNMENT BEING IN A POSITION TO ACT UNILATERALLY IF
AGREEMENT CANNOT BE REACHED BETWEEN THE PROVINCES CONCERNED.
NOVA SCOTIA MUST HAVE INVOLVEMENT PARTICULARLY, IN THE
LICENSING OF FISHING VESSELS IN THE SETTING OF QUOTAS AND
GENERALLY IN ALL MATTERS RELATING TO COASTAL FISHERIES.
