

MEMORANDUM TO THE PRIME MINISTER

I have just received a telephone call from Norman Spector with advance wording of a telex from Premier Bennett which should arrive within the next couple of hours:

I am writing to you on behalf of the nine provinces that signed the November 5th constitutional accord. The agreement reached in Ottawa is a significant achievement in the affairs of our nation and was only possible through compromise on the part of all of us. I have been asked by my colleagues to inform you that additional constitutional change should only be considered in Canada following the patriation of our constitution. My colleagues and I believe that further negotiation must not put at risk the accord and that the package should be approved by Parliament as it now stands and proceeded with without further delay.
