

SUMMARY REPORT

The attached documentation covers the period of March 11 to March 26. It is quite limited in nature. An ad, including a subscription offer was published in the newspaper Le Droit, by the "mouvement Vivère Inc.". Also the Ottawa Citizen, Le Devoir and Le Droit reproduced a telegram addressed to Jean Chrétien with a list of names supporting the pro-life movement. In the House of Commons, Mr. Gus Mitges spoke on abortion asking that the rights of the unborn child be entrenched in the Constitution.

Also included in the package are the following documents for reference purposes, dated prior to March 11, 1981:

- (1) one article from the Toronto Star on an all-party committee of MP's supporting the pro-life movement.
- (2) the brief from the Planned Parenthood Federation of Canada to the Joint Senate-Commons Committee and the Constitution (December 30, 1980).
- (3) the analysis of the proposed Constitution and how it will affect the rights of the unborn child in Canada submitted by the Right to Life Association of Toronto and area to the Joint Committee of the Senate and House of Commons on the Constitution (December 23, 1980).
