

In consideration of the transfer to the
 General Parliament of the power of
 taxation - the following sums shall
 be paid to each of the Provinces for
 Government to each Province for
 the support of their local Govt:

and legislatures -	\$ 80,000	
Upper Canada	70,000	
Lower Canada	60,000	
New Brunswick	20,000	260,000

And an annual grant in aid
 of each Province shall be made
 equal to eight per cent per head
 of the population as established
 by the Census of 1811 and in
 the case of New Brunswick and
 New Brunswick. by each subsequent
 decennial census until their
 population of each of these
 Provinces shall amount to ^{greater}
 100,000 souls. at which ~~time~~
 it shall thereafter in full
 said aid shall be a full
 settlement of all of the demands
 upon the Local Govt. for
 local purposes and shall be
 paid half yearly in advance
 to each Province -
