That on the application

Her Majesty in Council may
from time to time sanction the
appointment of additional
senators, so as that the whole
number shall in no case exceed
70, the proportions allotted to the

preserved. In case of an increase
after any such increase above
72, no appointment shall be
made without the sanction
of the British Government till
the whole number is reduced
below 72.
