

Resolved

That on the application of the Federal Government Her Majesty in Council may from time to time sanction an appointment of additional Senators, so as that the whole number shall in no case exceed 48, the proportions allotted to the separate sections being strictly preserved.

In case of vacancies after any such increase above 42 no appointment shall be made without the sanction of the British Government till the whole number is reduced below 42. —
